LAWN BOWLING PHYSICAL DISTANCING & SAFETY PLAN

Facility Name: Coronado Lawn Bowling Green

- This is an open-air facility and supervised by Coronado Lawn Bowling Board member(s) during operational hours.
- All measures of the San Diego County's Social Distancing and Sanitation Protocol must be in place.
- This checklist represents additional requirements for the Lawn Bowling Green to be operational. Post a copy of this Physical Distancing & Safety Plan at the entrance to the facility and other relevant buildings.

Measures to Protect Lawn Bowling Green Members and Participants:

- Members are instructed to welcome and greet everyone from a minimum of six feet. There will be no physical touching permitted with any guest or fellow staff member and all must maintain six-foot distancing.
- Members must be trained regarding protocols established by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and health experts. All members must be provided the requirements of How to Protect Yourself and Others <https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/prevent-getting-sick/prevention-H.pdf>.
- All members must follow County of San Diego and the City of Coronado's requirements for face coverings and other personal protective equipment.
- Members have been trained to recognize the Symptoms of Coronavirus (COVID-19) and know how to act responsibly if they detect or exhibit symptoms according to the CDC <https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/downloads/COVID19-symptoms.pdf>.
- Members will be screened, including a temperature check, before and after each shift.
- All participants will be screened, including a temperature check, upon entry to the facility.
- Only two (2) sets of three (3) participants at each of four (4) of the green's eight (8) rinks are allowed at a time. Participants will not be allowed inside the storage area together.
- Participants will be required to make a reservation in advance in order to use the green. The reservation must include the names of everyone using the green in case there is a need for contract tracing. No drop-in games or pick-up games are allowed
- All participants must wear CDC approved face coverings.
- All participants must be CLBC members.

Measures to Protect Participant Health:

- If a participant is sick or is feeling sick, they will not come to the lawn bowling green. Encourage all participants to wash their hands before coming to the facility.
- No payment will be due for use of the green, but booking/reservations must be made in advance online.
- All participants shall handle their own equipment.
- No general use equipment will be available for one-time use. Participants will be issued one set of bowls, jacks and a mat to be kept in their possession until normal play may resume. At no time will equipment be shared. Participants are encouraged to bring their own equipment in lieu of being issued Club equipment.
- Time intervals will be monitored to regulate the number of participants arriving at one time to ensure social distancing.

Measures to Protect Participants around the Lawn Bowling Green Area:

- Limit the number of participants arriving any one time which always allows for participants and members to easily maintain at least six-foot distance from one another.
- To assist with physical distancing, lines must be installed with six-foot markers for participants to maintain safe social distances.
- All members must be instructed to maintain at least a six-foot distance from participants and from other members.
- Remove any water dispensers that require contact. Trash cans should be touchless. Remove lids if present.
- Facility restrooms can remain open provided they are cleaned frequently and follow protocols established by the CDC and health experts. Restrooms will only be available for participants and members; no public access will be allowed.
- Members will monitor participant compliance of this safety plan while they are on the property.

Measures to Protect Participants and Staff after Completion of Activity:

- Guests are asked to dispose of their own trash into garbage cans.
- Guests are encouraged to wash their hands immediately after completing the activity. Social or group gatherings are not permitted.
- Physical distancing will be enforced by staff.


Measures to Increase Sanitization

- Disinfecting sprays or wipes that are effective against COVID-19 are available to sanitize frequently touched surfaces.
- Hand sanitizer, soap and water, or effective disinfectant is available to participants at or near each entrance of the facility and restroom.
- Staff must disinfect all high-contact surfaces frequently.
